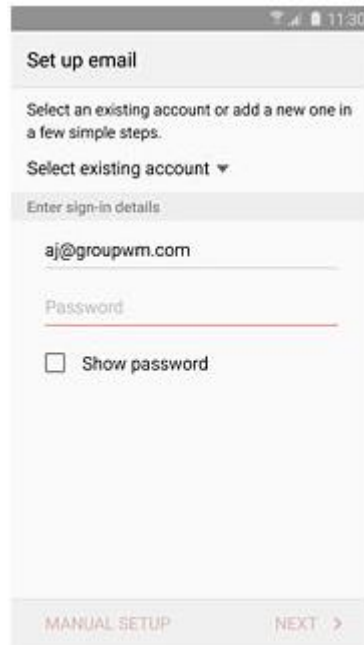
## Samsung Galaxy POP3/IMAP Email Setup

Go to

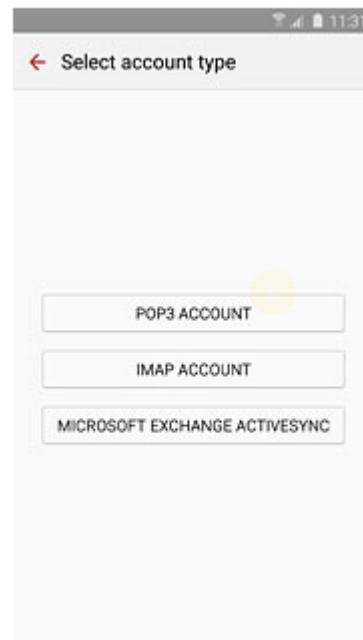
1. Apps

and email password


Then tap Next

account type




Enter your incoming mail settings

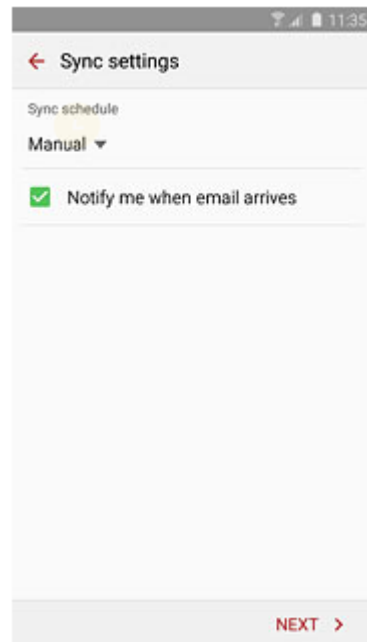
Enter your outgoing mail settings
