

HTC U 11

Getting Started



When you switch on HTC U 11 for the first time—or after you've done a factory reset—you'll be asked to set it up.

Tip: You can enable TalkBack to navigate by voice feedback before selecting the language. Press and hold two fingers on the screen until you hear a message saying that accessibility mode is enabled.

Walk through the on-device setup to choose your Internet connection, sign in to your Google® Account, set up device protection for HTC U 11, and more.

Use Android Backup Service if you've used it to back up your old phone before. On the screen that asks you which device to restore from, tap the name of your old phone model. Tap to choose the type of items you want to restore, and then tap Restore to proceed.

Otherwise, tap Don't restore.

If you have content such as media files and data that you need to transfer from an old phone.

Ways of transferring content from your previous phone

Depending on the operating system in your old phone, choose the proper method of transferring content to HTC U 11.

From an Android phone

On your old HTC or other Android phone, download the HTC Transfer Tool and use it to transfer your content to HTC U 11.

From an iPhone

Back up iPhone content to your iCloud storage, and then transfer the content to HTC U 11.

Note: Some features that need to connect to the Internet such as location-based services and auto-sync of your online accounts may incur extra data fees. To avoid incurring data fees, disable these features under Settings.
